Approve the Minutes

Clerk/Treasurer Report

- Financial report - Started the month of November with \$523,497.26. We deposited \$108,475.94 in non-tax income. Transferred \$61,000 from the BCMMA to the checking account to cover checks written, payroll taxes, and IRA. There were \$24,336.70 in outstanding checks. The ending balance totaled \$559,629.94.
- Tax letters will go out in the mail by the end of this week.

Chair Report

- Hills Road Bridge – nothing new to report.
- Recycling center attendant position – scheduling a closed meeting to interview several applicants that applied through Indeed.
- Snowplowing – discussed during budget hearing.

Road Crew Report and Transfer Station Report

Inbetween plowing and sanding, new strobe lights were installed on the tractor. Lots of tree trimming and brush cleanup were done on Woodland, 508, Hicks Landing and Sailor after the storm. Blades were taken off the chipper to get sharpened. Will use up salt/sand mix that we have, 100 yds, and will go through Lepke if need more.

Transfer station- Brush pile was burned Friday.

Items for Discussion and possible action:

Red Pines Subdivision (25 acres)

Waiting on the State to approve the plat map. Surveyor was out on the land.

Resolution for election inspector's new term

Our election inspectors' terms are up at the end of this year. Motion is made and seconded to approve Resolution 12-9-2025, which identifies the individuals interested in serving as poll workers for the elections to be held in 2026 and 2027. Motion carried.

Ordinance Designation Snowmobile Route – Big Elk Rd.
